## The 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Volunteer Appreciation





## *From Barbara . . .*

Last week I wrote about “being normal” and is there a “normal.” Some people would say that we’re not a “normal” parish. The fact that we are twinned parishes and that we don’t have a resident priest as our pastor could define us as “abnormal.” But what makes a parish? The Church is the people of God. We gather together as a faith community to celebrate the Eucharist. We pray for one another during the week. We have ministries that serve the poor and educate the faithful. We celebrate the sacraments. We have several priests that serve our parishes for our sacramental needs and other spiritual needs. We are different than most parishes in our leadership structure. Does that make us “abnormal?” Parishes with a resident priest also use different leadership models. The most important component of any parish is faith, how it is celebrated, and how it is lived out. We are different but we’re normal. On this Trinity Sunday, let us ask the blessing of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit on our parishes. Take time this week to reflect on the blessing that our parishes and your faith are to you.

Over the next couple of weeks we are going to conduct a special fundraiser to pay for the new roof on the parish house at Our Lady of Mount Carmel. While it belongs to OLMC parish, it is the residence of Sr. Val, our parishes’ Director of Religious Education, who serves both parishes. We invite parishioners of both parishes to participate. The Bright Envelope Fundraiser consists of 144 envelopes each with a dollar amount printed on it. Participants select an envelope with an amount they would like to contribute, place that amount in the envelope and return it to the parish. If all the envelopes are taken and returned we will collect \$10,440. Children can participate with some of the smaller amounts; groups can participate with some of the larger amounts; families can encourage every member to contribute no matter the size of the contribution. Envelopes will be available at both parishes. Please consider participating and thank you in advance for your generosity.

May God continue to bless us all.
