See General Livestock information. Entry fee: Adult: \$4.00 per animal; Youth: Free (Sponsored by Farm Credit)
Health and General Rules:

1. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) **issued after May 1 of the current year** is required. A current **rabies** vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is recommended for animals 3 months of age and older.
2. Individual official animal identification is required for all goats. Official ID includes: A USDA ear tag with a US shield; or a legible tattoo with herd and individual identification recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database a.k.a scrapie tattoo (flock ID in the right ear - state postal code and letters/numbers - and individual animal ID in the left ear; or a breed registration tattoo if the animals are accompanied by a registration certificate (copy acceptable) and the tattoo is legible.
3. For a list of vaccination requirements for out-of-state animals call the Fair office.
4. Space is limited. Entries will be accepted on a first-come first-serve basis. In the event that space for all entries is not possible, each exhibitor may be limited to 6 head. Health papers need to accompany animals.
5. No equipment, feed, hay, bedding, etc. will be allowed to be stored in pens in the barns. These items must be kept in trailers.
6. All livestock must be shown by the exhibitor that it is registered under unless the exhibitor has more than one animal in the class and then one animal must be shown by the registered exhibitor.
7. Judges reserve the right to rearrange the classes according to number of entries.
8. **Livestock may not be removed before 10:00 p.m. on Saturday and no vehicles or livestock trailers may go to the barns before 10 pm. All premiums will be forfeited by all exhibitors whose animals are being transported with a vehicle/trailer entering the grounds before 10 pm.**
9. **Junior Livestock market animals may be shown in breeding or market classes but not both.**
10. No more than two goats per exhibitor per class will be accepted.
11. Supreme Doe or Buck will only be awarded if there is at least a minimum of 10 doe or buck entered.
12. **The Livestock Entry Form can be found at the back of this book or on the Premium Book page on the web site at www.southmountainfair.com and must be returned to the South Mountain Fair by July 6, no exceptions.**

4. A Get of Sire consists of four breeding animals, any age or sex, the get of one sire. Get of Sire need not be owned by exhibitor.
