

Living Landscape Contest

General Rules:

See General Fair Rules and Regulations.

1. Competition is open to amateur gardeners. All entrants must purchase an exhibitor number for \$2.00.
2. Entrants will landscape an approximate area of 10'x10' near a fair building, as assigned, on Sunday July 20 or Monday, July 21, 2025 during registration. Displays must be complete by noon on Tuesday, July 22, 2025.
3. The display material may include live or dry plant material. No artificial material is permitted. **All materials used in the display, including mulch, must be removed at the end of the Fair.**
4. Plants must be displayed in containers as no digging of the grounds is permitted. The containers may be concealed with mulch or other similar material.
5. All plants in the landscape exhibits should be identified on a tag that can be viewed by the public.
6. The use of benches, fences and nonpermanent walkways are permitted.
7. Those wishing to enter a display must reserve a space two(2) weeks prior to the opening day of the fair.
8. The South Mountain Fair Association is not responsible for damage to displays by wind, rain, or individuals.
9. All pots must be marked with the owner's name, address and telephone number.
10. Exhibits must remain on display until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, the last day of the Fair. Violation of these rules will result in a forfeiture of premiums.

Judging

Points for landscape displays are awarded as follows:

Workmanship	20
Attention/Interest	20
Quality of Plants	20
Overall Appearance	30
